For 2023 we have partnered with <u>B1G1</u> (Buy One Give One), a social enterprise and non-profit organisation that ultimately wants to create a world full of giving. B1G1 achieves this by helping businesses, just like ours, create an impact with each designated business transaction.

So, how does it work for Walker & Sutcliffe and why are our clients integral to our charitable activity?

At Walker & Sutcliffe we would like to see our outputs support someone, somewhere with something! Through B1G1 we can do just that.



We have decided that every time a client joins our business, we will donate to B1G1. In addition, specific pieces of work completed by our team, on behalf of a client, will also trigger a donation too.

The work that we have chosen to support the Walker & Sutcliffe charitable giving includes:

- Annual Accounts
- Annual Self-Assessment Tax Return
- Payroll once a year
- Bookkeeping once a year

But what's important is that each of our clients chooses which global goal they would like to support. We then donate to the project that this goal is linked to.

From Purpose To Impact Driven

Practice Partner, Nick Ledgard, explains: "At Walker & Sutcliffe we don't just want to be purpose-driven, we want to be an impact-driven business. B1G1, which connects businesses with global goals and high impact projects that deliver tangible benefits, is a great way to do this."

In total, there are 17 global goals and each goal links to lots of meaningful projects. As a leadership team, we chose several projects for each global goal. These projects aligned with our values. We then asked our colleagues to choose one from each goal – the one they cared about the most.

The projects are vast and make such a difference in lots of different ways, so it wasn't easy for colleagues. But it was important to have each colleague involved in the process, after all, it is their hard work that triggers our giving!



In May 2023 we kick-started our plan and the impact so far has been significant.

In just four weeks, with the support of our team and help from our clients, we have achieved 2,254 impacts in the world.
